





EEA Emission Review Tool (EMRT) for the National Emission reduction Commitments Directive

The **EMRT-NECD** (Emission Review Tool for the National Emission reduction Commitments Directive) is a web-based tool hosted by the <u>EEA</u> to facilitate quality checks and reviews of national emission inventories reported by EU Member States under the **National Emission reduction Commitments Directive** (<u>NECD</u>, <u>Directive</u> 2016/2284/EU).

The emission **inventory** review process and the emission **projections** review process follow guideline documents provided at the bottom of this page.

- 1. Click 'Log in' in the top right corner of the screen.
- 2. If requested, enter your EIONET username and password.
- 3. Click '2024 Inventory' to start the review of emission inventories.

EMRT-NECD - Supporting Tool


IT IS

- A WEB-BASED TOOL hosted by the EEA TO FACILITATE QUALITY CHECKS AND REVIEWS OF NATIONAL EMISSION INVENTORIES reported by EU Member States under the new National Emission reduction Commitment Directive
- **USED BY THE REVIEW TEAM** to document the review findings and communicate (question and answers) with Member States

IT IS NOT

- a data server in order to access air emission inventory data
- a tool to perform recalculation or revised estimates


Definitions in the EMRT-NEC



Key definitions commonly used in the EMRT-NEC

- **Observation** (Observations are given a unique ID e.g. MS-1A-2023-0001)
- Question
- Conclusion
- Status of observation
- Workflow



EMRT- NECD General Workflow





ONLY the **FINAL QUESTION** with the request for an answer will be visible to Member State

 internal comment looping between the TERT experts will be not visible to Member State

ONLY the **FINAL ANSWER**, sent by the MS, will be visible to the TERT

internal comment looping between MS experts will be not visible to the TERT






